DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURES

Everyone will enter through the main church entrance (Door #1). Drop off and pick up will happen in classrooms on the second floor. Each day, parents will fill out the drop off/pick up sheet. At drop off, parents will sign their child in and give the name of the person who will pick the child up. At pick up, the designated pick up person will have to show a valid driver's license/photo ID to sign a child out.

HOW WILL I KNOW WHAT TEAM MY CHILD IS ON?

You will receive an email from us the week prior to camp letting you know what team your child is on and what activities he/she will be participating in. This email will also let you know which room to drop off and pick up your child in each day and if they will need to bring anything with them.

T-SHIRTS

You can purchase "It's Your Move" T-Shirts during registration only. We will not have a camp store during the week of Quest Camp.

WRISTBANDS

Each participant will have a wristband representing their team's color. These wristbands must be worn at all times during Quest Camp. Please do not remove your child's wristband until the end of Quest Camp on Thursday. The wristbands are waterproof and tear-proof.
