### **KEY PASSAGE: 2 CHRONICLES 7:14:**

If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

### **BIG PICTURE QUESTION & ANSWER:**

How did God plan to fix what sin broke?

Before He created the world, God planned to send the Messiah to save sinners.

### **THIS WEEK'S STORY POINT:**

Habakkuk learned to have faith and trust in God.

### **BIBLE STORY - HABAKKUK:**

- Habakkuk felt like only evil was happening all around him.
- When he asked God to stop evil, God said He planned to use evil people to punish Judah's sin.
- Habakkuk did not understand why God would use evil to punish evil.
- Habakkuk learned to have faith and trust in God.

### **CHRIST CONNECTION:**

Habakkuk lived at a time when evil seemed to be everywhere. By faith, he trusted God's promise that God would deliver His people. Injustice, violence, and wickedness surround us today, but we can live by faith and trust that Jesus will return to make all things right.

### **FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

- Why is there still evil in the world?
- How can we trust God when we face difficult times or evil events?
- Who defeated evil once and for all?

### **FAMILY ACTIVITY:**

Talk to your kids about evil in the world. Remind them that, although many difficult and bad things happen, God is ultimately in control. Encourage them to think of ways they can be part of God's good work in the world.
