INTRODUCTION TO THE GOSPEL OF MARK

The Gospel of Mark emphasizes actions and deeds. Jesus is on the move - healing, casting out demons, performing miracles, hurrying from place to place, and teaching as He goes. So often in Mark, everything happens immediately. As soon as one episode ends, another begins, and the call of Jesus to anybody willing to listen is to ***"FOLLOW ME!"***

As you spend the next several months reading the Gospel of Mark and hearing the words of Jesus we hope and pray that you will answer the call to ***"FOLLOW ME."***



For some, reading the Bible can be a daunting task. Where do I start? How much do I read? What do I need to do? Our suggestion is to read the assigned passage and follow this method:

S SCRIPTURE

Write out the verse or passage that stuck out most to you.

O OBSERVATION

What does the scripture say? What truth can you learn? Are there any warnings? Commands? Principles? What is the overall message?

A APPLICATION

What is God asking you to do?
How can you apply that truth to your life today?
How does that verse/passage call you to act differently?

P PRAY

Turn these truths into a prayer and ask God to show you how to apply this to your life.
